## Grading System: Tests and Written Testing Procedures

$\checkmark \quad$ Each section of the curriculum will be the subject of a test, quiz, or exam.
$\checkmark \quad$ Students must pass all sections with a minimum of $\mathbf{8 0 \%}$ or higher.
$\checkmark$ Test, quizzes, and/or exams may be given from any chapter of the book, instructor presentation, and any video shown during class.
$\checkmark \quad$ Online lectures and online lecture quizzes and chapter quizzes must be completed to unlock the unit exams.
$\checkmark \quad$ Failure to complete any quizzes will result in a zero (0) grade and a failing score on the unit exam.
$\checkmark \quad$ Each test will encompass all the chapters covered during that module only.
$\checkmark \quad$ There will be a midterm exam that will encompass all the chapters covered from unit exams 1 through 4.
$\checkmark \quad$ The Midterm exam must be passed with an $80 \%$ or (B)
$\checkmark \quad$ After the midterm exam, the student's academic progress will be assessed to determine the statistical probability of completing the program with an $80 \%$ or higher. If it is determined that the student is not able to pass the course successfully, the student will be dismissed from the program.
$\checkmark \quad$ There will be a final exam that will encompass all the chapters covered during the program.
$\checkmark \quad$ The final exam will consist of a written test which must be passed with an $80 \%$ or (B) and a practical skill assessment which is pass or fail.
$\checkmark \quad$ There is one (1) retake for any failed section(s) of the practical skills assessment.
$\checkmark \quad$ Students will be assessed the comprehensive final exam twice, with an NREMT review in between the attempts. Students must pass at least one attempt.
$\checkmark \quad$ Students must have and maintain an overall score of $80 \%$ (B) or better at the completion of the program to graduate.

The following shall result in immediate dismissal from the program.
$\checkmark$ Failure on both attempts of the comprehensive final exam
$\checkmark$ Failure of the practical skills assessment and retakes
$\checkmark$ Failure to complete externship hours and paperwork

## Grading System: Tests and Written Testing Procedures

$\checkmark \quad$ Each section of the curriculum will be the subject of a test, quiz or exam
$\checkmark \quad$ Students must pass all sections with a minimum of $\mathbf{8 0 \%}$ or higher
$\checkmark \quad$ Failure to achieve a minimum score of $\mathbf{8 0 \%}$ or higher on any written test will require the student to re-test within one week or at the discretion of the lead instructor and retakes will be given at a time convenient to the instructor

- Regardless of passing score achieved on retest an $80 \%$ will be recorded.
$\checkmark \quad$ Test, quizzes, and/or exams may be given from any chapter of the book, instructor presentation, and any video shown during class
$\checkmark \quad$ Failing three module tests is automatic dismissal
$\checkmark \quad$ A failure of the module test will follow the above makeup rule if this failure is not the third exam/test failure
$\checkmark \quad$ Online lectures and online lecture quizzes and chapter quizzes must be completed to unlock the unit exams
$\checkmark \quad$ Failure to complete any quizzes will result in a zero (0) grade and a failing score on the unit exam.
$\checkmark \quad$ Each test will encompass all the chapters covered during that module only
$\checkmark \quad$ There will be a midterm exam that will encompass all the chapters covered from unit exams 1 through 4
$\checkmark \quad$ The Midterm exam must be passed with an $80 \%$ or (B)
$\checkmark \quad$ There is a retake allowed for the midterm, provided the student has not failed three exams prior to the midterm
$\checkmark \quad$ There will be a final exam that will encompass all the chapters covered during the program
$\checkmark \quad$ The final exam will consist of a written test which must be passed with an $80 \%$ or (B) and a practical skill assessment which is pass or fail
$\checkmark \quad$ There is no retake allowed for the final written exam
$\checkmark \quad$ There is one (1) retake for any failed section(s) of the practical skills assessment
$\checkmark \quad$ Students must have and maintain overall score of $80 \%$ (B) or better at the completion of the program in order to graduate


## The following shall result in immediate dismissal from the program.

$\checkmark$ Failing score on any make-up test
$\checkmark$ Failure of the final written exam shall constitute dismissal from the program
$\checkmark$ Failure of the practical skills assessment and retakes
