## **Badge Policy**

Photo Identification (ID) cards are issued to all students enrolled in EMT-Basic, EMT-Paramedic and Firefighter I&II, and must be worn visibly at all times to identify them as students. EMT-Basic and EMT-Paramedic students shall also wear their ID cards during clinical and field rotations as well. ID cards are issued by Academic Program Advisors (APA).

ID cards expire on the scheduled class end date. Withdrawn students must surrender their ID badge upon removal from the program. Graduates must return their badge at the completion of each course. The APA will reactivate and return the badge at the start of a new program.

Lost ID cards must be replaced immediately by contacting an APA. The replacement fee is \$25, and new cards will be issued within 1–2 business days.

ID cards are used to access the CSRIPS campus. Students must not grant access to anyone without a badge, whether student or staff. Violations shall result in demerits. Holding or propping open doors violates safety procedures. Anyone without a badge should be directed to the CSRIPS Administration Offices at 4150 NW 120th Ave.

Students are prohibited from wearing their ID badge outside of class or using it to gain access to unauthorized locations. Students found doing so shall be subject to demerits up to dismissal.
