## **EMT-Basic Admission Requirements**

## The TABE

Prior to registration, applicants must complete the Tests of Adult Basic Education (TABE), 13 Level A Complete Battery, no more than two (2) years prior to the start date of the course they plan to enroll in. Applicants must register for the test and pay the registration fee via visit <a href="https://www.CSRIPS.org">www.CSRIPS.org</a>.

To be eligible for consideration for the EMT-Basic program, an applicant must achieve the following minimum scores.

Reading: 563Math: 577

Language Arts: 573

Achieving the minimum score does not guarantee admission. Students who fail to meet the minimum score must wait 3 months before sitting for another test.

### **TABE Exemptions**

Applicants may be exempt from taking the TABE if they have achieved qualifying scores on an approved standardized test. CSRIPS will accept scores listed on an official high school transcript as official records, in addition to official score reports. The assessment must be taken within two years of the intended course start date.

# **Mandatory Information Session**

All prospective applicants are required to attend a **Mandatory EMT-Basic Information Session** for their intended registration period. This session provides important information about the admissions process, including requirements for externship rotation compliance, background checks, and drug screening.

The Information Session application is initiated from the application link on the EMT-Basic program page on the CSRIPS website.

### **EMT-Basic Application**

The EMT-Basic application is a 2-step process.

- Step 1 Basic student information along with payment of the application fee.
  - You will receive an email within 24 hours with instructions for completing Step 2 within your MyCSRIPS student portal. You are required to complete Step 2 by the deadline stipulated in the email.
- Step 2 Student will be required to:
  - acknowledge the Refund Policy (required)
  - acknowledge the Release and Waiver (required)
  - acknowledge the Photo Release and Waiver (required)
  - select alternate payment options (if applicable)
  - select Veteran benefits (if applicable)
  - upload complete physical exam form (required)
  - upload CSRIPS BLS Healthcare Provider card (required)
  - upload health insurance id card (required)

- upload diploma (high school or college or GED) (required)
- upload Driver's License (required)

The student should only complete Step 2 after receiving instructions from the Academic Program Advisor. Once Step 2 has been completed, the student's application is considered complete and will be reviewed for consideration.

Applications are reviewed and scored based on the Points-Based system. Selected students will receive a *Conditionally Accepted* letter. To secure enrollment, conditionally accepted students must complete all precourse requirements, including a drug screening and a background check, prior to the start of class as documented in the letter. Failure to complete all tasks by the issued deadlines will result in the admission offer being rescinded and removal from the upcoming class roster.
